



Requirements Analysis Indexing

"Give end-users consistent, reliable access to information" (CDWA)

- Precision is getting more and more important in the context of large-scale aggregation of metadata!
- Indexing in Europeana
 - only "administrative" facets
 - no browsing aids for the user in terms of content

Requirements Analysis More specific metadata

Mandatory descriptive metadata elements so far

- Object / Work Type (<> dc:type) [AAT]
- Title (<> dc:title)

Additional requirements for museum content may be

- Generic classification, using AAT top hierarchy [AAT]
- Repository/Location [TGN]
- At least one event information with at least one of
 - Actor [ULAN]
 - Cultural Context [AAT]
 - Date

 - Place [TGN]

- Need for distinction between indexing and display ["findable" and "readable"]
- Need for possibility to display uncertainty
- Need for possibility to transmit type of contribution, roles, extent
 ["readable" and "meaningful to audiences"]
- Need for distinction between information coming from the content provider and automatically enriched information ["trusted process"]

ar ebony and boullework cabinets; each with two doors mounted in gilt bronze with a kneeling, bearded, man (Socrates) and seated woman (Aspasia), right hand and points with her left; surrounded by garlands of medals. White marble tops. Twenty-five of these cabinets, dating from three century, have been identified. The first group, made under the direction of André-Charles Boulle himself, probably dates from 1705-15; the repetitions from Boulle's workshop of the 1720s and 1730s. A third group dates from the period after 1760 when a number of new from the first or second periods, were restored. Although the earliest of these cabinets were certainly intended for medals, XIV as diplomatic gifts (Présents du Ro), by the 1730s they were as likely to have been used - in spite of their very specific decoration - simply as articles. In the case of these cabinets and several others of this second group, there is no physical evidence that they ever contained medal shelves, al foot which was originally designed to support the weight of medals. The figures of Socrates and Aspasia (the mistress of Pericles), constant se cabinets, derive either from Michel Corneille's painting of 1673 on the ceiling of the Salon des Nobles at Versailles or perhaps from a drawing Boulle's possession. Both Figures of Aspasia on the cabinets are signed on the reverse by an unidentified bronze-maker, C(?) Richar[d]. The en 1643 and 1697, record the principal events of Louis XIV's reign and are often (as in the present case) of surprisingly low quality. ary passion for Boulle furniture and acquired many splendid examples. These cabinets may have been purchased from the dealer vere at Carito se in the Blue Velvet Closet in 1818 and in the library by 1826. Despatched in 1828 to Morel & Seddon for restoration and placed re subsequently transferred to the Grand Corridor. One stamped DELORME (for J.L.F. Questo disegno, cosi' come l'altro con l'intera Veduta di piazza Navona, e' sicuramente da riferire ai primi anni ottanta del Seicento quando Gaspar van Wittel, da poco a Roma, visitava la citta' e prendeva appunti sui luoghi piu' significativi. Il disegno e' di grande qualita' e si direbbe che l'autore si fosse molto esercitato per eseguire con cura le statue dei fiumi della fontana. La grandiosa opera di Gian Lorenzo Bernini, commissionata da Innocenzo X, era relativamente recente poiche' era stata eretta nel 1651, poco piu' di vent'anni prima dell'arrivo di Gaspar van Wittel a Roma.




