

The National Library Service (SBN) is the network of the Italian libraries providing services to libraries and to end-users.


SBN:

- is a network promoted by the Italian Ministry for Cultural Heritage and coordinated by ICCU
- acts in cooperation with Regions and Universities
- is based on the cooperation among libraries
- online since 1997





- → Portal interface available also in English
- \rightarrow 15.000 Editorial contents

- \rightarrow 990.536 items from Museums
- \rightarrow 851.686 items from Libraries
- \rightarrow 485.466 items from Archives



- Opac SBN, 13 M bibliographic records
- Edit16 books from XVI sec 67,000 records
- Manusonline, 250,000 records
- Historical catalogue 215 historical catalogues from 35 libraries): about 6.600.000 records)
- Digital Library over 1.000.000 records /10 M files (jpg, mp3, text) from the digital collections



MuseiD-Italia is:


- an integrated section of Culturaltalia
- a national register of museums, monuments and archaeological parks (3.800) interoperable with all regional databases and links to their website
- a digital library based on Fedora Commons Framework for the storage and publication of digital objects describing
 - Museums (about 300)
 - Museum collections (650)
 - Digitized Museum objects (95.000)

Network of GLAMs

Consortium: 40 partners from 21 Member S

Ministries and government agencies, GLAMs, aggregators, research centres, SMEs.

Main goal: aggregation of 3,6 millions data to Europeana 80% from museums (about 500 institutions)

DCH-RP: a Roadmap for the long-term preservation in DCH

A Coordination Action with cultural institutions, e-Infrastructure providers and a wide network of international organisations willing to contribute to the project

Aims:

- to harmonize data storage and preservation policies in the digital cultural heritage sector at European and international level
- identify more suitable models for the governance, maintenance and sustainability for the infrastructure devoted to preservation of digital content
- Roadmap for preservation
- Registry of tools and services
- Proof of concepts

A DP Roadmap for DCH

To develop a commonly agreed vision of distributed digital preservation architecture relying on e-Infrastructures

Four areas identify the policy domains that require intervention:

- Harmonisation of data storage and preservation
- Improved interoperability, including integration of preservation within the overall workflows for digitisation and online access
- Establishment of conditions for cross-sector integration, transferring knowledge and know-how
- **Governance models** for infrastructure integration, to foster participation in larger e-Infrastructure initiatives, and aggregation and re-use of digital resources
- Federated access: the authentication and authorization of the user that is one key aspect of e-Infrastructures (ICCU has joined IDEM, the federated IDEntity Management for service access) of GARR the Italian Research & Education Network, NREN))

Italian EU Presidency

Policy on DCH:

The digitisation and online access to cultural heritage represents a strong opportunity to foster the creative industries and the job creation throughout the reuse of the digital resources.

The Presidency supports the development of Europeana as unique access point to the European cultural heritage, and the national aggregators that play a fundamental role in ensuring core quality content to the European portal.

Italian EU Presidency

Policy on DCH:

The Presidency aims at pursuing the harmonization of national research programmes in the field cultural heritage through the involvement of all stakeholders: researchers, cultural heritage experts and einfrastructure providers.

The goal is to develop an integrated data and service platform in the cultural heritage field that allows the interoperability between the various national systems for the management, access, and preservation of digital cultural heritage.

Italian EU Presidency

Develop cooperation between researchers, e-infrastructure providers and cultural institutions to:

- implement a federated infrastructure devoted to Cultural Heritage and Digital Humanities
- create a Virtual Research Community in the field of DCH and Digital Humanities
- develop recommendations and guidelines for the use of digital infrastructures by cultural institutions


